

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 2-2009

AMENDING CHAPTER 6-45 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED "RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE"

WHEREAS, there is created in the Code of the Township of Moorestown, under Chapter 6, Section 45, a Recreation Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Advisory Committee, pursuant to the Code, consists of nine regular members and two "additional" members; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council wishes to increase the membership of the regular members from nine (9) to eleven (11); and

WHEREAS, the Township Council wishes to amend the term dates and clarify the qualifications of the "additional" members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

Section 1: Chapter 6-45 "Recreation Advisory Committee" of the Code of the Township of Moorestown, shall be amended as follows:

Within the Department of Parks and Recreation, there shall be a Recreation Advisory Committee to consist of ~~nine~~ eleven (11) members to be appointed by the Council, each for a term of two years. The Council may also appoint one or two additional members, each for a term of one year to run from ~~May 1 to April 30~~ July 1 to June 30 of each year. The additional members shall be students entering into their junior year of high school. ~~The terms of the additional members serving this term shall be deemed to be one full term hereunder.~~ The Committee shall provide for its own organization and shall consult with and advise the Council, Manager and Director from time to time with respect to recreational policies, programs and activities within the Township. No person may serve more than four successive full terms.

Section 2: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law.

Section 5: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 2-2009.
