

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 20-2006

**AMENDING CHAPTER 1-8 OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED
“SALE OF CODE BOOK”**

WHEREAS, Chapter 1-8 of the Code of the Township of Moorestown provides that copies of the Code Book may be purchased from the Municipal Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Clerk has recommended that the Township no longer provide for the direct sale of the Code Book due to the costly expense incurred by the Township and taxpayers for duplication; and

WHEREAS, as a matter of convenience, the Code Book is available, at no cost to the public, on the internet; and

WHEREAS, the Code Book is always available, at no cost, for public inspection in the Office of the Municipal Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Code Book may be purchased by the public directly with the Township’s codification company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Section 1-8 of the Code of the Township of Moorestown shall be deleted in its entirety and the following language shall be placed in its stead:

§ 1-8 Sale of Code book.

Copies of the Code of the Township of Moorestown may be purchased directly from the Township of Moorestown’s Codification Company at the cost set by said company. The Municipal Clerk shall provide members of the public with the name, address and phone number of said company upon request.

The Code of the Township of Moorestown shall be available for public inspection, at no cost, and at all times, in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

The Code of the Township of Moorestown shall be available on the internet and available to the public at no cost.

- Section 2. Continuation. In all other respects, Chapter 1 shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 3. Severability. In the event that any section or paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.
- Section 4. Repealer. Any and all ordinances, inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
- Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication and in accordance with law.
- Section 6. Short Title. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 20-2006.

NOTICE

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on August 14, 2006. This ordinance will be further considered for final passage by the Township Council at a meeting to be held in the Council Chambers of Moorestown Township, 111 West Second Street, Moorestown, NJ on August 28, 2006 at 8pm or at any time and place to which such meeting may be adjourned. All persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning such ordinance. During the week prior to and including the date of such further consideration, copies will be made available at the Municipal Clerk's Office in said Municipal Building to any member of the general public who shall request such copies.
