Steve asked about the situation with the Farm Stand on Borton Landing and Hartford Rd. It is looking derelict and neglected. Gina suggested that the person operating the stand could be having difficulty obtaining products.

Pat commented on the continuing trash which seems to be part of the front décor of Studio Ten Salon on 5 East Main St. Patty has asked the enforcement officials to look into this and will double check.

Gina mentioned that it is difficult for her to drive the watering truck on the sidewalk in front of Carollo's because it doesn't fit. It was suggested to eliminate the plants in front of their store.

Karen asked if there is any news on the recycling. Patty said no, but we can look on a Burlington County site for updates.

D'Arcy suggested a new pedestrian walkway from High St. to Passariello's. This would work out well when Percheron Park is constructed. We can pass this idea along to Sue Mammarella.

Steve is suggesting the new CHOP facility on Main and Marter as a recipient for 2022 Arbor Day Award. They have done an exemplary job with the building and the landscaping. They incorporated the design ideas suggested made by Dave Donachy.
