

**TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**

**RESOLUTION NO. 216-2017**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE  
TRANSFER OF \$35,000 FROM THE 2017 CURRENT BUDGET APPROPRIATION  
FOR SNOW REMOVAL TO THE SNOW REMOVAL RESERVE TRUST FUND**

WHEREAS, P.L. 2001, c.138 permits municipalities to lapse unexpended balances budgeted annually for snow removal; and

WHEREAS, the Township recently established a dedicated trust fund for the purpose of providing a stable source of funds for the costs of snow removal in years of unusually high snow occurrences; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with P.L. 2001, c.138 and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-58, it is necessary for the Township Council to authorize the transfer of unexpended balances to the snow removal reserve during the last two months of the fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the township staff requests to transfer the available balance of \$35,000 from the 2017 Current Budget: Roads Repair and Maintenance – Other Expenses appropriation to the Snow Removal Reserve Trust Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, in Burlington County, State of New Jersey, that the transfer of \$35,000 from the 2017 Current Budget: Roads Repair and Maintenance – Other Expenses appropriation to the Snow Removal Trust Fund is hereby authorized in accordance with P.L. 2001, c.138.
