RESOLUTION NO. 36-2014

**AUTHORIZING TAX ASSESSOR TO
PERFORM STATUTORY DUTIES**

WHEREAS, Statutory provision is made for review and correction of errors prior to certification of an assessment list; and

WHEREAS, statutory provision is also allowed for the discovery and correction of errors after establishment of the tax rate; and

WHEREAS, changes in property ownership, at times, necessitates adjustments in the veterans' and senior citizens' deductions allowed on the assessment list; and

WHEREAS, responsibility for maintenance and correction of the assessment list rests with the local Assessor - subject to laws and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that the Assessor fulfilling the duties and requirements of his office, be authorized to file with the Burlington County Board of Taxation such appeals as may be necessary to maintain accuracy and equality in the assessment list of Moorestown Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Assessor is hereby authorized to execute stipulations on behalf of the Township; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Assessor shall report all such changes to the Township Manager on a monthly basis. Said report will be presented to the Council for their review.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution accompanies any appeal filed by the Assessor with the Burlington County Board of Taxation.
