EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Board of Fire Commissioners, Moorestown Township Fire District No. 1, has decided that there is a need to replace all SCBA units in the fire department. Our current units are approaching 15 years in age and the air cylinders will no longer be serviceable after year 2025.

The Board of Fire Commissioners, Moorestown Township Fire District No. 1, has also decided that our current Breathing Air Compressor that fills the fire department's Cascade Unit and the firefighters' SCBAs has reached its useful life. The unit is in excess of 35 years in age and is no longer serviceable.

A "yes" vote will authorize the Board of Commissioners of the fire district to place the above amounts in the 2025 Fire District Budget to purchase the items listed.

If the referendum is approved (a "yes" vote) by in excess of 50 percent of the voters casting a vote, the referendum will be deemed adopted.

A "no" vote means that Restricted Funds will not be utilized, and the item will not be placed in the 2025 budget.
