



# PROJECT ORIGINATION

Any project that you can undertake could use this process to determine applicability of regulations (examples: swings sets, fences, home renovations, additions, large mulch beds, etc.)



## Determine if the project area or structure is in a regulated flood plain

Go to <https://msc.fema.gov/portal/home> for guidance.

### Flood Plain Application

- An application for a floodplain development permit shall be submitted to the floodplain manager.
- May be submitted individually or along with a zoning or construction application.
- Plans required as applicable.
- Elevation certificate as applicable.
- Substantial improvements/ damage form.
- In addition to the local development permit, some projects may require approval from NJDEP, depending on the scope & location of the project.
- You will receive notification by email or letter when review of the flood plain application is complete.

*\*If your application is denied, see comments from the flood plain manager for further instructions.*

## Determine if the project is regulated by Moorestown Zoning Code Ch 180

### Zoning Application

- A zoning application shall be submitted to the zoning official.
- Shall be submitted with the construction application as applicable.
- Shall include a \$50 zoning fee.
- Shall include floodplain approval, survey and plans as applicable.
- Shall include any board approvals.
- Can take up to 10 business days for review depending on current volume
- You will receive notification by email.

*\*If denied, see comments from the zoning official for further instruction.*

## Is the project regulated by the Uniform Construction Code, NJAC 5:23?

### UCC Application & Plan Review

- A Uniform Construction Code construction permit application shall be submitted to the construction official.
- See township's construction office page for further information on submission.
- Can take up to 20 business days for review depending on current volume of applications.
- Fees due upon completion of plan review
- The agent listed on the application will be notified of results by email.
- Plans are reviewed by up to 4 plans examiners; results will be emailed after all reviews are conducted.

- Every permit shall culminate with a certificate only when all inspections have been approved including final inspections and all other department/agency requirements have been met.
- A permit will remain open until a certificate is issued.
- Moorestown Township requires all open permits to receive certificates for any transfer of ownership.
